The Eight Worldly Concerns:

- 1 being glad to profit or acquire something and being unhappy not to
- 2 being happy to be well and comfortable and unhappy not to be
- 3 being happy when another praises us and unhappy when they don't
- 4 being happy to hear good news and unhappy not to

As said in Guide to the Bodhisattva Conduct: If there are others who praise us why be unhappy when we are criticized? If there are others who criticize us why be happy when we are praised?

and again from Guide to the Bodhisattva Conduct:

—Surely material wealth will enable me to live, And then shall be able to consume evil and do good— But if I am angry on account of it Will not my merit be consumed and evil increase?

And what use will be the life Of one who only commits evil,

If for the sake of material gain He causes (the merits needed for) life to degenerate

—Surely I should be angry with those Who say unpleasant things that weaken other beings' (confidence in me)— But in the same way why am I not angry With people who say unpleasant things about others?
