Your mandala expanding throughout space in knowledge of all things, Beautiful thousand-fold light striking the lands of trainees, Fully illuminating all of Buddha's Teachings in their entirety, With devotion I prostrate to the Great Jewel of the Kagyu.

Third, Again Honoring All of My Root Gurus

O glorious and precious root Guru
Please take seat of lotus at my heart.
Caring for me in your great kindness,
Please grant attainments of body, speech, and mind.

Equal to all Buddhas in qualities of realization,
Yet surpassing all Buddhas in kindness to me,
I pray at the feet of my root Guru, O Protector,
Please turn the minds of myself and all beings towards the Dharma.

All you who have become disciples of the Sugatas, Those Gone to Bliss,
Throughout the billions of worlds of the ten directions
All of you who wish to hear the Dharma
Raining down here and now, may you come here!

In languages of devas, nagas, and yakshas, Languages of kumbhandas and human beings, In the sounds of whatever beings exist, In every language, I shall teach the Dharma.
