The four yuganaddha, unifications, or unified pairs are:

Union of appearance and emptiness
Union of bliss and emptiness
Union of clarity and emptiness
Union of pure awareness and emptiness

In his Gangama Mahamudra Instructions, Tilopa said,

If we are beyond all subject-object duality, it is the "king of views." If we have no distraction, it is the "king of meditations." If we exert no effort, it is the "king of action." If we lack hope and fear, the fruit will manifest.

Zhabkar Tsogdrug Rangdrol said,

The emptiness of ones mind does not obstruct appearances and within emptiness un-grasped appearances shine forth. Appearances do not obstruct emptiness as appearances themselves are primordially empty by nature.
